

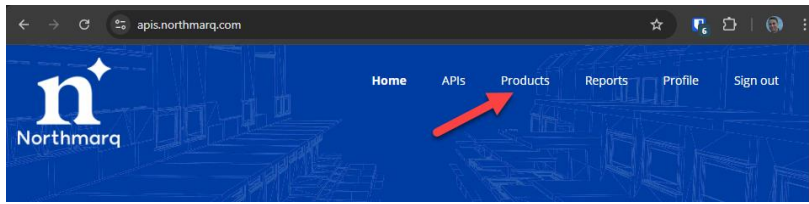
Northmarq APIs Getting Started

Access

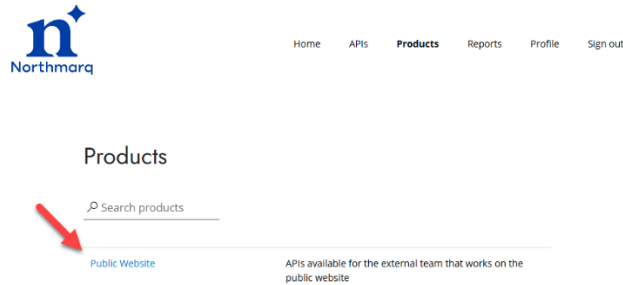
1. Sign up at <https://apis.northmarq.com>
2. Contact 52f96c68.northmarq.onmicrosoft.com@amer.teams.ms requesting access to the API you are interested in.
3. The Northmarq team will respond with the Product information that you have been added to.
4. Log out and sign back into <https://apis.northmarq.com/>

Subscription

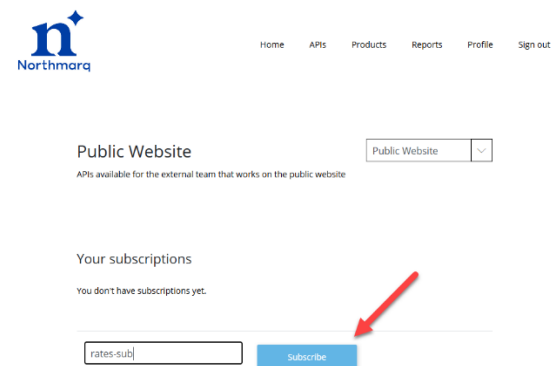
5. Go to Products



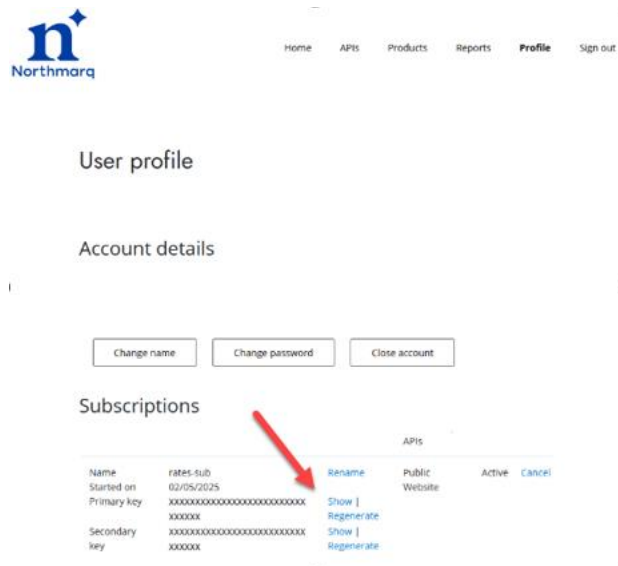
6. Click on your assigned Product. In this example the product is "Public Website"



7. Type in a name for your subscription and click subscribe.



8. You should now see a new subscription with a token. You can click the show button to view and copy the value.



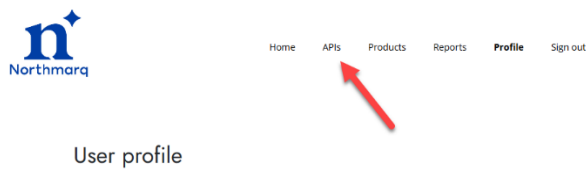

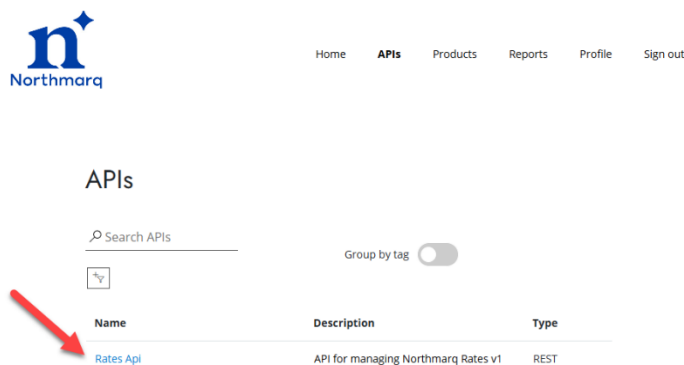

10. Click on the API you are interested in. This example is showing "Rates API"

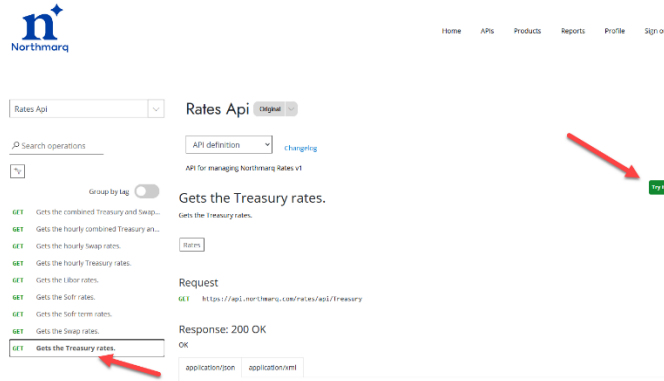

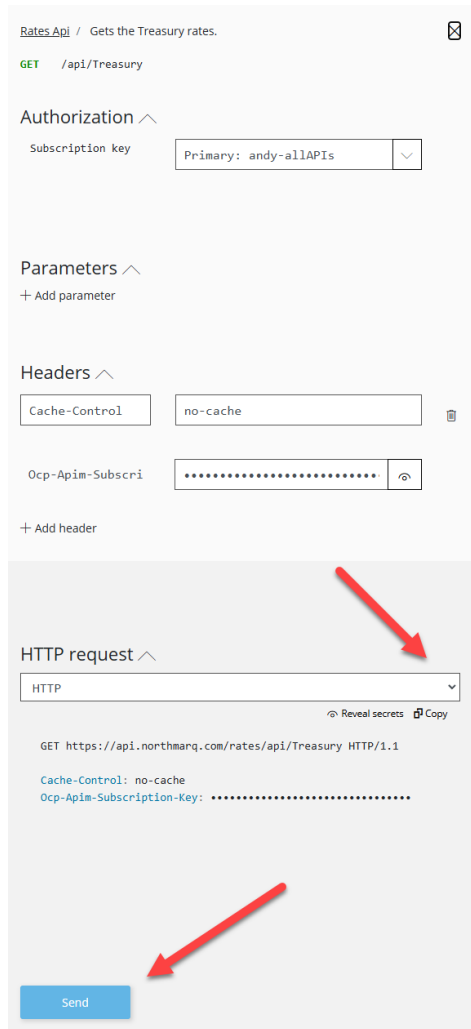
